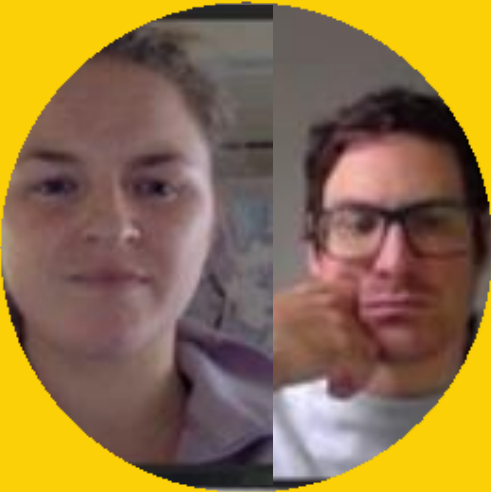
Giving us a fantastic insight into the NPYWC Youth Services, students felt inspired by Brett and Anne's work, describing it as 'mind-blowing.'
